<p>'Digital Literacy Instructor' (DigLin),</p>	<p>The European 'Lifelong Learning Programme' (LLP) Multilateral Project 'Digital Literacy Instructor' (DigLin), started in January 2013, runs for three years, until 2015. The main aim is to substantially advance literacy training for non-literate adult immigrants learning to read for the first time in Dutch, English, German or Finnish. DigLin is developing Computer-Assisted Language Learning (CALL) systems – advanced learning materials that allow individualization of instruction and teacher-independent learning.</p>	<p>http://diglin.eu/</p>	<p>Free to use – requires email registration. Neither is suitable for pre-entry learners. They also offer other languages.
